

## Verifone Update on Managed Network Service Provider Program (MNSP)

**After May 1, 2019, new orders for Verifone equipment will not include an Enhanced Zone Router (EZR).** All new installations should make use of the MNSP Solution of your choice as long as it is certified by the network.

### Certified Providers

We now have many sites running with our 6 certified MNSP partners. Two more MNSP partners are coming soon. All certified partners have successfully completed QA validation and are in the field now supporting live sites.

Please note that it is important to check with your Major Oil or processing network partner to ensure you are using a solution approved for their network.

### Outdoor EMV

As announced on December 12<sup>th</sup>, 2018, support for outdoor EMV will require the deployment of a MNSP Solution. Verifone has been working with each MNSP partner to ensure that the requirements for outdoor EMV are established to streamline the conversion and ongoing support of additional networking requirements for sites installed with Verifone Petroleum POS Systems.

### Key Points:

- Verifone has previously announced that deploying a device with a certified MNSP partner will be required to implement outdoor EMV. Several hundred sites have already made the switch to an MNSP program
- Verifone has 6 partners certified and two more currently working through certification

### Continuing Support of Verifone's Enhanced Zone Router (EZR)

Connected EZR's in the field will continue to be supported until a conversion to Outdoor EMV or a future date sometime in Q1 of 2020.
